



## Associate Policy, Quetta

### I. Background

Pak Alliance for Maths and Science (PAMS) is a non-profit organization that aims to inspire a love for learning, and to develop cognitive and critical thinking abilities in Pakistani children. PAMS provides technical support to the federal and provincial education departments, donor agencies, and its partners on implementing scalable solutions in Pakistani government schools, in addition to conducting research on education policy.

### II. Why we are hiring

PAMS is currently providing technical assistance to the federal and provincial education departments on multiple projects; the selected candidate will be working with the Policy team based in Islamabad as well as providing support to the School Education Department as part of PAMS-led Delivery Unit based in Quetta. This is a five-year project, with the employment contract for this role valid till June 30<sup>th</sup> 2025 and extendable annually. The Policy stream is a key component of PAMS' operations, seeking to create impact through meaningful engagement with a diverse set of stakeholders to provide recommendations informed by practice to improve the learning experience in classrooms and schools across Pakistan. The organization's head office is in Islamabad, with policy units' teams also based in Karachi, Lahore, Gilgit, Peshawar, and soon in Quetta.

### III. Scope of Work

The incumbent will report to the Lead, Programs and Policy, and work closely with the Senior Associate, Research and Lead, Impact and Outreach. The objective of this position is to provide program coordination and technical support on policy to the School Education Department (SED), Balochistan. She will be working closely with the management on research, policy briefs, and supporting the state's education delivery departments with policy implementation. The Policy Associate will be required to undertake the following routine tasks:

- Contribute to the creation and sharing of knowledge by summarizing and documenting results, lessons learned and good practices from the implementation of the project/field partners
- Establish and maintain relationships with relevant officials in SED Balochistan
- Ensure regular communication with the Learning team for required adjustments on operational matters to ensure optimum results
- Participate actively in meetings, and undertake monitoring visits to assess progress of different aspects of the project including field monitoring visits, coordination meetings and other relevant partners forums
- Coordinate with district focal persons, Head Teachers / Principals and school focal persons for implementation of program related activities and interventions, as well as for research, consultations or focus group discussions.
- Regular and continued coordination with the regional/partner organizations and field-related office staff
- Engage with relevant policy fora regularly
- Support program by conducting regional orientations/training as needed

### IV. Qualifications and Skills Required

- A minimum of a four-year undergraduate degree, preferably in the social sciences
- Strong oral communication and writing skills in English and Urdu; knowledge of Balochi, Brahui or Pashto is a plus
- Motivated, proactive, and committed personality with a keen attention to detail
- A minimum of one year of work experience, preferably including data analysis
- An interest in public policy reform, particularly in education policy

### V. Deployment

- This is a Quetta-based position
- The selected candidate will be offered a contract till June 30<sup>th</sup> 2025, subject to an annual renewal.
